Residential Customer Citywide Curbside Clean-up

The City of Silvis & Republic Services will conduct a citywide curbside bi-annual clean-up

(2018 dates noted)

If your regular trash service is picked-up on **Mondays**:

- Spring pick-up is scheduled for the week of **April 16**
- Fall pick-up is scheduled for the week of **October 15**

If your regular trash service is picked-up on **Tuesdays**:

- Spring pick-up is scheduled for the week of **April 23**
- Fall pick-up is scheduled for the week of **October 22**

To help in the effort, please observe the following guidelines:

- ✓ All items must be set-out by 6:00 a.m. on the **MONDAY** of your pick-up week – regardless of your regular trash service pick-up day
- ✓ Once Republic Services has collected items in your neighborhood, they will **NOT** be coming back through
- ✓ Please be patient, items set out for this service will **NOT** be collected with your regular trash pick-up – it will be picked up sometime during the week listed
- ✓ All items must be placed at the curb or along the street/alley where your trash is usually collected
- ✓ Large items, such as furniture, will be picked up if placed at the curb or along the street
- ✓ Carpet must be rolled **AND** tied in sections no longer than 6 feet
- ✓ Small items must be containerized. Cardboard boxes should be kept dry prior to pick-up
- ✓ Choose containers carefully – **ALL** containers will be taken unless marked “**SAVE**”
- ✓ Containers must weigh no more than 50 pounds each
- ✓ Papers must be placed in plastic bags or tightly bundled with strong string or cord
- ✓ Shredded paper must be bagged
- ✓ Plastic bags must weigh no more than 20 pounds each

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- TIRES
- APPLIANCES
- E-WASTE (e.g. TELEVISIONS, FAX MACHINES, or COMPUTERS)
- WATER HEATERS
- EXPLOSIVES or FLAMMABLES
- CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS
- GAS ENGINES or GAS CYLINDERS
- PAINTS, OILS, or OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE
- MEDICAL WASTE
- CONCRETE
- SHINGLES
