Re: Personnel and Public Safety Meeting

Attendance: Tony Trulson, Caryn Unsicker, Kathy Hall, Bob Rockwell, Chief VanKlaveren, Abi, Jim Grafton

Location: City Hall 121 11th Street

The joint Personnel and Public Safety meeting was called to order at 2:30 pm and it was noted a quorum was present for one agenda item.

Chief VanKlaveren explained that the last person on the police hire list declined the offer so a new list (through testing) needs to be established. The list was certified with 7 people about 18 months ago. The Chief said he reserved a spot in academy in February...he's hopeful to have the list established by Christmas. The position to fill would not be the school resource officer; the resource officer would come from within the ranks. The Chief continued that applicants for the resource position

Alderman Trulson asked if one of the council members could sit in on the interviews for the resource position. The Chief thought that would be a great idea. Testing takes about three and a half months for new officer training. The resource position would include coverage of Barr and the Jr. High school in East Moline. The Chief reported that he asked to set up a meeting with Civil Service to set up training date.

Committee was in agreement to move forward with the testing for a police officer and the item would be placed on the November 7th COW agenda.

There were no other agenda items and the meeting was adjourned at 2:40pm.
