Mayor Carter administered the oath of office to new Liquor Commission members David Mumma and Lyle Lohse.

Agenda item: Section 10-119 age of employee selling alcohol.  
Mayor Carter noted that there had been a request from the Silvis HyVee store Director Emily Bockeoman to allow sales clerks between the ages of 18 thru 20 to scan purchases of package alcohol. Clerk Nelson noted that according to the State of Illinois the age for employment is left up to each local Liquor Commission. After much discussion this wording was agreed upon:

*Section 10-119*

*No person under the age of 21 years shall be employed in any establishment licensed by the City to sell alcoholic liquor for use or consumption with the following exception:*

- a) *Class E license holders with 5 or more contiguous check-out lanes may have employees between the ages of 18-20 run the register for the purchase of alcohol.*

It was the recommendation of the Silvis Liquor Commission to advance this ordinance amendment to the Ordinance Committee for action.
