Meeting Minutes

December 6, 2018

Juan Escontrias called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Bob Roman made a motion to accept the minutes from November as written. Motion seconded by Bruce Nelson. All ayes – motion carried.

The board does not support paying the bill for Bornhoeft Heating and Air for \$135. This belongs to Building and Grounds. Bob Roman made a motion to pay all bills for the previous month. Motion seconded by Bruce Nelson. All ayes – motion carried.

Old business:

- Schadt Park concession stand: Have considered rebuilding larger building in current spot or move it down below. The board would like to place the concession stand behind the home dugout with the bleachers next to it between the dugout and the light house. Bob Roman will draw up the plans and we will review at a future meeting.
- Dog Park: Silvis Resident, Chris Baker attended and shared her concerns with the placement of a dog park in a residential area. She feels that the park is fully utilized as is and it isn't desirable to have a dog park so close to the homes. 20 people have signed a petition objecting to a dog park in this area. The board is considering other options in Silvis and will consider it on hold until other locations can be evaluated.
- Ice skating Rink: Dave has concerns about potential vandalism. The board discussing locking it each evening and adding a camera. We need to have rules posted. Dave will order signs soon. It will likely be January before the rink is usable.

New business:

- Meetings for 2019: Bob Roman made a motion to move the January meeting from 3rd to the 10th. Motion seconded by Carrie Toland. All ayes – motion carried.
- Volleyball: The park board is aligned allowing age 16+ into the league if the other teams are supportive. Consider limiting it to two minors per team. Carrie Toland will discuss with team captains and get their input.
